BLOGGING ACADEMY COURSE KICKS OFF NEW SHIFT LEARNING

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — Award-winning blogger and Birmingham native Wade Kwon will teach beginners' classes in partnership between the BIRMINGHAM BLOGGING ACADEMY and SHIFT LEARNING. The June 27 sessions will show students how to get started in setting goals, creating sites, brainstorming content, and building audiences.
